

## **Equipment & Maintenance Specialist**

## Responsibilities

- Establishing and maintaining a system to manage the calibration and control of all precision measuring equipment, tools and machinery in the Company
- Managing SAESL's tools and equipment to meet the Company's contractual and regulatory obligations
- Ensuring that proper records are kept and updated for all tools and equipment, including calibration reports, load test reports and any other reports and records related to the maintenance and
- calibration of tools and equipment
- Liaising with production to ensure that the removal of tools or equipment for calibration or regular maintenance does not result in work stoppage
- Liaising with vendors to arrange for regular preventive maintenance of equipment
- Purchasing replacements for tools and precision measuring equipment taken out of service due to damage, breakage, failure or loss of accuracy
- Tracking all in-house and out-house tooling calibration validity, and setting target dates for calibration completion in association with the calibration vendors
- Promoting, and ensuring compliance with, the requirements of the Company's SMS within their work area
- Ensure that work areas and equipment are risk assessed and hazards and control measures are communicated to the staff in the areas of responsibilities
- Head, EMS shall be responsible to collate the department budget annually to ensure sufficient resourcing for operations and projects
- Head, EMS shall also stand in to act on behalf of the Manager, EMS in the absence of the Manager on delegated authority
