Responsibilities

- Verify declaration on release documentation prior to engine return to customers
- Prepare engine release documentation
- Approve of engine logbook and other required documentation release
- Evaluate OEM and Airlines on release requirements
- Conduct AD compliance
- Support investigation of engines rejected from service, where necessary
- Support external audits, where necessary
