



Manager, Operations (FoF)

Responsibilities

- Responsible for the creation and maintenance of the FoF workstream (roadmap) for the Operations startup phase in collaboration with the FoF program manager and other startup sections
- Develop, agree and control the project plan including Budget & Cost management for FoF Operations with key milestones and deadlines, manage interdependencies and alignment between projects, and ensuring clear and transparent allocation of tasks & cross-workstream activities in collaboration with the FoF project management
- Leading the FoF Operations startup teams including facility maintenance, equipment and tooling define its accountabilities, ensuring appropriate skills and competencies of the team members
- Management of the day-to-day business for Operations during the startup phase which includes change management, ensure effective communication and escalation and report progress according to the governance and reporting structure
- Responsible for the development and implementation of the FoF maintenance concept for the FoF, facility, equipment and tooling
- Responsible as SAESL Point-of-Contact to collaborate with FoF project management teams, machine suppliers and builders in order to avoid unexpected issues at the interfaces when the large machinery /equipment is installed to the building
- Responsible for the preparation and execution of the FoF Repair Transfer plan in collaboration with the FoF & Calshot Engineering teams
- Responsible to identify and specify the entire shopfloor equipment required for FoF in addition to the major repair equipment specified by repair engineering
- Support the repair engineering team on specifying the major repair requirement in line with the FoF repair strategy

- Responsible for the definition of the layout for the individual cells and the entire workshop in collaboration with engineering and other stakeholders and assigned advisors
- Review and accept the structure of the FoF engineering documentation and instructions relevant for the shopfloor
- Provide the required support by Operations for the development and implementation of the Knowledge-Based-Manufacturing & other IT software packages, quality system & process landscape and other processes for FoF
- Responsible for the definition, documentation and implementation of the processes and procedures for Operations
- Buying off capacity plans and ensuring adequate support for the timely provisioning of qualified personnel. Ensure an appropriate training program in collaboration with the training organisation.
- Maintain relationship with internal stakeholders, external partners within the operations community for FoF
- Leading FoF Operations after the startup phase

Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in aerospace/mechanical/materials engineering with more than 10 years of relevant industrial experience
- Experience in leading business units in the section of operation, production engineering or repair engineer
- Experience with industry 4.0 and Digital Remanufacturing environment desirable but not mandatory
- Experience in maintenance of facilities, large equipment or tooling is desirable
- Good interpersonal, communication and presentation skills
- Highly self-motivated decision maker with strong analytical skills and very result driven
