Responsibilities

- Maintain lab database for individual processes to record all test samples issued, received and evaluation results
- Ensure proper storage and document of all test coupons and evaluation records.
- Maintain SDS database for chemical products utilised in lab
- Responsible for maintaining, servicing and cleaning of all lab equipment
- Ensure good housekeeping is maintained in the lab
- Ensure compliance with health, safety and environmental regulations and policies
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisor

Requirements
