Key responsibilities

- Treasury and assets management, including debt capital financing and managing banking relationship
- Lead a small corporate finance team

- Liaising with internal and external auditors, and tax agents

- Minimum 10 years of corporate finance, treasury management and accounting or auditing experience, with at least 5 years in supervisory capacity

- Ability to work as a team player and independently, willing to be hands-on at handling complex and ambiguous situations
- Exceptional interpersonal skills to engage effectively with colleagues across divisions
